

Sunday before Theophany of Christ,

Martyrs Theopemptos, Theonas the former magician, Venerable Syncletica of Alexandria, Venerable-martyr Romanos of Athos.

The Sunday before Theophany marks a time of spiritual anticipation as we prepare to celebrate the Baptism of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. This pivotal moment in the life of Christ revealed the fullness of the Holy Trinity: the voice of the Father declared, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased," the Holy Spirit descended in the form of a dove, and Jesus Himself stood in the waters of the Jordan. Theophany, meaning "manifestation of God," is a feast of divine revelation, reminding us of Christ's mission to renew and sanctify creation. On this day, we also reflect on the ministry of St. John the Baptist, whose call to repentance prepared the way for the Lord. As we hear his words, "Prepare the way of the Lord; make His paths straight," we are invited to renew our commitment follow to Christ. embracing the transformative power of His grace in our lives.

The Feast Day of Theophany

Theophany is the name of the feast day that celebrates when Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River. Look at the words of the Troparion to learn more about what happened. The dashes will help you know how long to sing the words.


Theophany Troparion

When Thou, O Lord, wast bap - tized in the Jor - dan, the wor - ship of the Trin - i - ty was made man ~ i ~ fest.

The voice of the Fa-ther did bear wit --- ness un to Thee, and called Thee His be - lov - ed Son.

And the Spir ~ it, in the form of a dove, did con ~ firm the con ~ stan ~ cy of the words.

O Christ our God, Who didst ap - pear and il -- lu - mi - nate the world, glo - ry to Thee, O Lord.



On the day of Theophany we learned that God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We also learned that when Jesus stepped into the Jordan River, the water was made clean. On the feast day, January 6, we remember that one day all of nature will be made clean and new again. Here is how we celebrate the feast.

AT CHURCH. At the service of the feast, we pray as Father dips the handcross in a large bowl of water. In this way, the water is made holy. Then Father sprinkles water on the walls

of the church and on us, as a blessing. We also drink some of the holy water.

OUR HOUSE BLESSING. In the days after

Theophany, Father comes to our homes. We need to prepare for this special visit. Look at the checklist on the right.

Checklist for Father's Visit

- we set out a white tablecloth
- we place a bowl and candle on the cloth, and a donation
- we turn off anything making noise, or distracting, and turn the lights on in each room
- we gather the family together, pray, sing, and as Father goes into each room, we point out where the icons are



Father blesses our home because it is to be a holy place, where we "commend ourselves, each other, and all our lives unto Christ, our God." Each year we are refreshed and renewed with the holy water of Theophany.

THEOPHANY

THEOPHANY (from GR *theophania*) means shining forth or manifestation of God. The Old Testament contains many stories demonstrating God's immense love for His creation and the extent to which He is willing to go in order to bring human beings into fellowship with Himself (God manifested Himself to Abraham, Jacob and Moses).

In the New Testament, THEOPHANY marks the Baptism of Christ by the glorious Prophet and

Forerunner John the Baptist. Christ's baptism in the Jordan was "theophany" because it was the beginning of our Lord's public ministry. It was also a "theophany" in that the world was granted a revelation of the Trinitarian nature of God: the Father's voice is heard from Heaven, the Son of God is incarnate and standing physically in the Jordan, and the Holy Spirit descends on Him in the form of a dove (Mt. 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11; Luke 3:21-22; John 1:31-34.) The Icon of the Feast tells the story from the Gospels in images and color.

The theme of "manifestation" or "revelation" is also expressed with the symbolism of light. In the hymn of the Feast we sing, "Christ has appeared and enlightened the world." The Church celebrates on this day the illumination of the world by the light of Christ.

THEOPHANY is one of the Great Feasts of the Orthodox Church, celebrated on January 6. In mystic commemoration of the Baptism of Christ in the Jordan, the Great Blessing of Water is performed. As the Troparion of the Feast is sung, the celebrant immerses the Cross into the water three times and



then proceeds to sprinkle the water in the four directions of the world. The holy water so blessed is used by the priests to bless the homes of the faithful.

عيد الظهور الإلهي (عيد الغطاس)

تَشْتَقُّ كلمة THEOPHANY الإنكليزية من كلمة "theophania" اليونانية وتعني إشراق أو ظهور الله. يحتوي العهد القديم على قصص عديدة تُظهر حبَّ الله الفائق لخليقته ومدى استعداده للعمل على إعادة بني البشر إلى حضرته . (فالله قد أظهر نفسه لإبراهيم ويعقوب وموسى).

في العهد الجديد، يشير الظهورالإلهي إلى معمودية السيد المسيح من قبل النبي المجيد السابق يوحنا المعمدان. هذا وتُعتبر معمودية المسيح في نهر الأردن ظهوراً إلهياً الأنها كانت بداية خدمة ربنا التبشيرية العامة. كما كان أيضاً ظهوراً إلهياً ، من حيث أنه أظهر للعالم طبيعة الله الثالوثية: حيث يُسمع صوت الأب من السماء، وابن الله المتجسد واقف بالجسد في نهر الأردن، والروح القدس يَحُطُّ عليه بهيئة حمامة (متى 21-13) و (يوحنا 1: 31-34). إن أيقونة العيد تُخبِر بالحدث كما ورد في الأناجيل بالصور والألوان.

يتم التعبير عن موضوع "الظهور" أو "الوحي" من خلال رمز النور. هذا ونرتل في العيد قائيلن، "ظهرالمسيح وأنار العالم" إذ تحتفل الكنيسة في هذا اليوم بإنارة العالم من نور المسيح.

عيد الظهور الإلهي هو أحد الأعياد العظيمة في الكنيسة الارثودوكسية ويُحثَفَلُ به في السادس من كانون الثاني . وفي الإحتفال الروحي بذكرى معمودية السيد الممسيح في نهر الأردن يتم تقديس الماء . وفي أثناء ترتيل طروبارية العيد، يقوم الكاهن بتغطيس الصليب في الماء ثلاث مرات ومن ثم برش الماء في الاتجاهات الأربع لهذا لعالم . هذا ويستخدم الكهنة الماء الذي تم تقديسه كما سبق ذكره في تقديس بيوت المؤمنين.

RESURRECTIONAL APOLYTIKION IN TONE THREE

Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm. He hath trampled down death by death, and become the first-born from the dead. He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the Great Mercy.

APOLYTIKION PARAMON (EVE) OF THEOPHANY IN TONE FOUR

River Jordan was turned back by Elisseus' mantle once, * when the fiery man of zeal Elias had been taken up; * then were its waters divided hither and thither. * The running streams became dry passage unto him, * truly as a sign and type of Baptism, * whereby we pass to the other side of * the shifting stream of this fleeting life. * Christ hath appeared in the Jordan River, to sanctify the waters.

APOLYTIKION OF ST. GEORGE IN TONE FOUR

As deliverer of captives and defender of the poor; healer of the infirm, champion of kings; victorious Great Martyr George, intercede with Christ our God; for our souls' salvation.

KONTAKION OF THE FOREFEAST OF THEOPHANY IN TONE FOUR

In the running waters of * the Jordan River, * on this day the Lord of all * crieth to John: Be not afraid * and hesitate not to baptize Me, * for I am come to save Adam, the first-formed man.

THE SYNAXARION

Today in the Holy Orthodox Church is the Paramon (Eve) of the Theophany (Epiphany) of our Lord, God and Savior Jesus Christ. On January 5, we commemorate the holy Martyrs Theopemptos, bishop of Nicomedia, and Theonas the former magician.

Verses

That Theopemptos might die, let him say: Contesting, I die, my head by the sword severed.

Martyr Theonas cried out with the Psalter: They laid me in the lowest pit, as saith David.

On the fifth, Theopemptos left life with a sword's help.

Theopemptos was among the first to suffer martyrdom under Emperor Diocletian, who threatened Theopemptos with death if he did not deny Christ. The courageous bishop responded to the emperor: "It stands written, 'Do not be afraid of those who kill the body' (Luke 12:4), 'but cannot kill the soul' (Matthew 10:28)." Theopemptos suffered from hunger and was tortured in various ways. Finally, the emperor summoned the magician Theonas to outwit this Godly man through magic. Theonas dissolved the most potent poison in water and gave it to Theopemptos to drink. Theopemptos traced the sign of the cross over the glass and drank the poison. Theonas, upon seeing that the poison had no effect on Theopemptos, turned to the emperor and shouted, "I, too, am a Christian and bow down before the Crucified One." Theopemptos died by the sword, and Theonas was buried alive. Both entered the Kingdom in 298.

On this day, we also commemorate Venerable Syncletica of Alexandria and Venerable-martyr Romanos of Athos. By the intercessions of Thy saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.

THE EPISTLE (Sunday before the Theophany)

O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance. Unto Thee will I cry, O Lord, my God.

The Reading from the Second Epistle of St. Paul to St. Timothy. (4:5-8)

Timothy, my son, always be steady, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. For I am already on the point of being sacrificed; the time of my departure has come. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, and I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved His appearing.

THE GOSPEL (Sunday before Theophany)

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark. (1:1-8)

The beginning of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. As it is written in Isaiah the prophet, "Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, who shall prepare thy way; the voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight." John the Baptizer appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. And there went out to him all the country of Judea, and all the people of Jerusalem; and they were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. Now John was clothed with camel's hair, and had a leather girdle around his waist, and ate locusts and wild honey. And he preached, saying, "After me comes He Who is mightier than I, the strap of Whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I have baptized you with water; but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

A beautiful celebration of Thanksgiving and Love between Godparents and Godchildren!



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
