### Saint Euphimia visit to Elder Paisios

"Saint Paisios was going through a very difficult time. At that time a problem had arisen in the Church and many bishops had gone to him asking for his help. However, it was a very complicated problem and even if he wanted to, he was unable to help them. As he himself said,

no matter from which angle you look at the problem, you come face to face with a spiritual impasse. So, he decided to turn his efforts in solving the problem into prayer.

Father Paisios constantly prayed for God to give a solution to the Church's problem; he prayed especially to St. Ephemia: "St. Euphemia, you who miraculously gave a solution to the serious problem the Church was facing in the fourth century, take the Church out of its current difficulty!"



One morning, at nine o' clock, when Father Paisios was reading the service of the third hour, he suddenly heard someone discreetly knocking on his door. The Elder asked: "Who is it?"

Then, he heard a woman's voice answering: "It is me, Euphemia, Father."

"Which Euphemia?" he asked. There was no answer. There was another knock on the door and again he asked: "Who is it?" The same voice was heard saying: "It is Euphemia, Father." There was a third knock and the Elder felt someone coming inside his cell.

Then the Elder told the saint: "Say: Glory to the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." St. Euphemia clearly repeated those words and immediately Father Paisios knelt and venerated her. Afterwards, they sat and talked for quite a while; he could not specify for how long, as he had lost all sense of time while being in the presence of the saint. She gave the solution for all three matters he had been praying about.

In the end he said to her: "I would like you to tell me how you endured your martyrdom." The saint replied: "Father, if I knew back then how eternal life would be, and the heavenly beauty souls close to God enjoy, I honestly would have asked for my martyrdom to last for ever, as it was absolutely nothing compared to God's gifts of grace!"

### THE SYNAXARION

On July 20 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate the fiery ascent as it were into the Heaven of the holy and glorious Elias (Elijah) the Thesbite.

### **Verses**

He withheld the rain and thrice brought down fire from Heaven, Now Elias parteth the stream and upwards hasteth. On the twentieth, thou wast caught up in a chariot, O horseman Elias.

Elias was born in the town of Tishba for which he was called the Thesbite. When Elias was born, his father Savah saw an angel of God hovering around the child, wrapping the child in fire and giving him a flame to eat. This foreshadowed Elias's fiery character and his God-given fiery power. Elias confronted the Israelite King Ahab and his evil wife Jezebel. They worshipped idols and were turning the people away from serving the One and Living God. Jezebel, a Syrian, persuaded her husband to erect a temple to the Syrian god Baal. Through great miracles Elias displayed the power and authority of God: he closed up the heavens, so that there was not any rain for three years and six months; he lowered a fire from heaven and burned the sacrifice to his God which the pagan priests of Baal were unable to do: he accurately prophesied to Ahab that the dogs will lick up his blood and to Jezebel that the dogs will consume her flesh. Before his death Elias took Elisseus (Elisha) and designated him as his successor in the prophetic calling. Elias was taken up into the heavens in a fiery chariot by flaming horses. He appeared on Mount Tabor to our Lord Jesus Christ with Moses on the Transfiguration. Before the end of the world Elias will appear again to put an end to the power of the anti-Christ (Revelation, Chapter 11).

On this day, we also commemorate Righteous Iliya Chavchavadze [ee-LEE-yah chav-chah-VAD-zay] of Georgia.

By the intercessions of Thy Saints, O Christ our God, have mercy on us. Amen.

#### CONDOLENCES TO HIS BEATITUDE PATRIARCH JOHN X

Your Beatitude Patriarch John X, Patriarch of the Great City of God, Antioch, and All the East, the Most Blessed and Most Reverend:

With expression of immense respect and appreciation of your fatherhood, we, the metropolitans of the archdioceses of Antiochian Orthodox Church in North and South America, joined by all of our spiritual children whom by the grace of the Lord are cared for by us, write this letter to Your Beatitude to offer our heartfelt condolences for the martyrdom of some of your spiritual children, who have ascended to the Almighty God, their Lord and Creator, and we say with one voice: "Christ is risen!"

This is our greatest consolation, our faith in the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who destroyed and conquered death, and rose victorious.

Without remising, through Your Beatitude, we extend to all the families of the injured the same condolence, "in resurrection and eternal life," which is our only hope, supplicating God Almighty to heal the wounds of all those suffering as a result of this cowardly terrorist act that took place a few days ago at a house of worship, the Church of St. Elias in Damascus.

Your Beatitude,

We empathize with the deep pain that has afflicted your loving heart, as a faithful father and shepherd of the Lord's flock in our Antiochian Church. Our prayers are always raised for Your Beatitude, for all your spiritual children, and for all those under your blessed care in the Holy See of Antioch.

Today, we specifically mention our beloved homeland, Syria and Lebanon, a homeland that has been distinguished throughout the ages by the coexistence of all its communities, regardless of their backgrounds and religions. They are one people, children of one homeland who share a common destiny.

Indeed, the people of this homeland have endured harsh conditions for hundreds of years, including hunger, poverty, and persecution at the hands of strangers. Many of them were forced to leave and dwell in different parts of the world.

Today, we are instilling in their children and grandchildren genuine love for their homeland and a connection to their blessed roots. But what has happened and is happening these days is alien to their minds and way of thinking, and unacceptable to humanity. Terrorism, bombings, and the indiscriminate killing of innocents are alien to authentic Syrians. Indeed, what is happening these days in Damascus and the rest of the Syrian provinces is very puzzling.

Those killed in a house of worship by the hand this criminal terrorist are Syrian citizens, and their martyrdom – as you mentioned in your eulogy – is a martyrdom for the homeland and religion.

Yes, the homeland is for everyone, and religion belongs to God, the Creator of all, and everyone will be held accountable for their religion by God, the Just Judge.

The divine scriptures teach respect for God's creation, and that what is different is also a creation of God. Whoever denies the humanity of others that differ from him violates God's will. Attacking others is an attack on against God himself, who is the God of peace and love that created man to live and not to die a senseless death.

Your Beatitude,

What is happening today in Syria, especially in Damascus, the historical and primal center of our Antiochian Orthodox Patriarchate, is no secret to anyone, and it is completely alien to Syrian culture and all its people.

Therefore, we, joined by all the spiritual children of our blessed parishes, and by many friends from our countries, condemn these terroristic and takfirist acts that have reached the highest levels of criminality with the attack on innocent people who were praying peacefully in their houses of worship.

Unlike the follower of terroristic and takfirist ideology who comes to destroy everything, even prayers and supplications, we begin all our prayers with supplications for the peace of the whole world, for civil authorities, the people, and the inhabitants of our countries.

We reject any takfirist ideology that undermines human dignity and distorts Syria's ancient history as a land of monotheistic religions and the authentic cradle of Christianity, as history and the Holy Scriptures attest: the place of conversion of Paul, the Apostle of the Nations, and the Apostle Ananias, the Street Called Straight, and all of Syria's monuments and heritage from north to south.

We know that terrorism kills, not enlivens; it fragments and tears nations apart, and sees any difference only as a disagreement that must be eliminated. This contradicts the will of God, the Creator and Master of all.

We also know that the phase that Syria is experiencing today is delicate and critical; yet, these terroristic crimes disrupt its peace, and the massacres and unrest spread sectarian strife among the one unified Syrian people.

However, this is a time of establishing and building up, not of destruction and doubt; a time of reconstruction, not of undermining; a time of freedom, not of tyranny, in which all segments of the Syrian people work together, regardless of their religion or ideology, united by one homeland in one accord. Patriotism unites, not divides.

We reiterate that religious and ideological terrorism are rejected altogether, at all times and in all places, regardless of their source, because they negate human freedom and undermine the principle of love for humanity.

Therefore, today, from our position as hierarchs of the Antiochian archdioceses abroad, we assure Your Beatitude that we stand by your side in our condemnation and rejection of terrorism in all its forms, degrees, and types against any human beings, regardless of their affiliation, religion, race, or color, not only in Syria, but throughout the world.

We lift up our fervent prayers and supplications to the Creator, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, to whom belongs all glory, that He may save all of humanity from the clutches of terrorism and from everything that causes the migration and displacement of peoples outside their homelands.

Finally, our father, Your Beatitude,

Our message in the churches abroad is one of love and faithful care. Therefore, we strive to instill hope in the souls of our Mideastern children abroad.

This terrorist crime that occurred at St. Elias Church in Damascus, and other crimes in all Syrian provinces and cities, will not make us forget our commitment to our homeland, nor will it shatter the hope of building its future in cooperation with all its components, or the dedicated work of everyone together, regardless of their religion or ideology. This is because our homeland, with its ancient civilization, is capable of rising up through the determination of its authentic children.

We conclude this letter by repeating with one voice and one heart the phimi of Your Beatitude and saying:

JOHN, the most holy, most blessed and most reverend father, chosen by God, Patriarch of Antioch, the great city of God, of Syria, Arabia, Cilicia, Mesopotamia and all the East, father of fathers, master of masters, shepherd of shepherds and thirteenth of the holy apostles, our Father and Chief Shepherd, may God grant him many years!

### The Reading from the Epistle of St. James. (5:10-20)

Brethren, take as an example of suffering and patience the prophets who spoke in the Name of the Lord. Behold, we call those blessed who were steadfast. You have heard of the steadfastness of Job, and you have seen the purpose of the Lord, how the Lord is compassionate and merciful. But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by Heaven or by earth or with any other oath; but let your yes be yes and your no be no, so that you may not fall under condemnation. Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is any cheerful? Let him sing praise. Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man has great power in its effects. Elias was a man of like nature with ourselves and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again and the heavens gave rain, and the earth brought forth its fruit. My brethren, if any one among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from the error of his way will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.

### Lecture de l'épître catholique de St. Jacques

Mes frères, prenez pour modèles de souffrance et de patience les prophètes qui ont parlé au nom du Seigneur. Voici, nous disons bienheureux ceux qui ont souffert patiemment. Vous avez entendu parler de la patience de Job, et vous avez vu la fin que le Seigneur lui accorda, car le Seigneur est plein de miséricorde et de compassion. 
